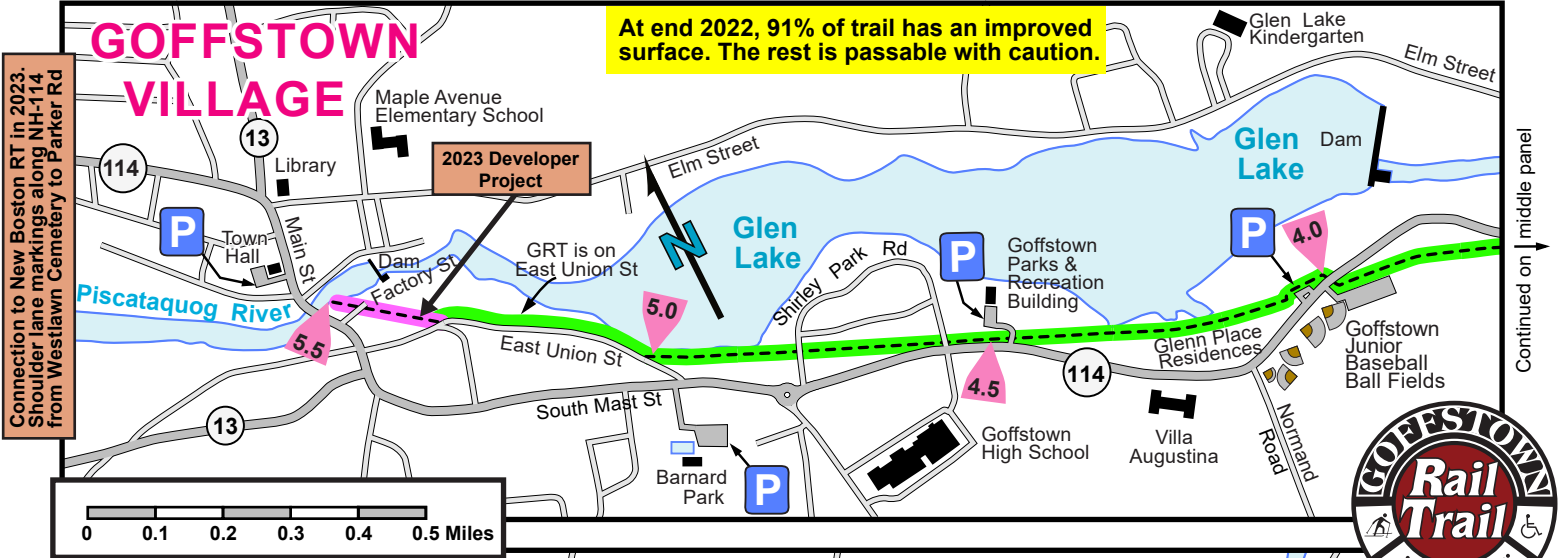


Goffstown Rail Trail

 Car Wash Section 0.05 mi (\$4,300)

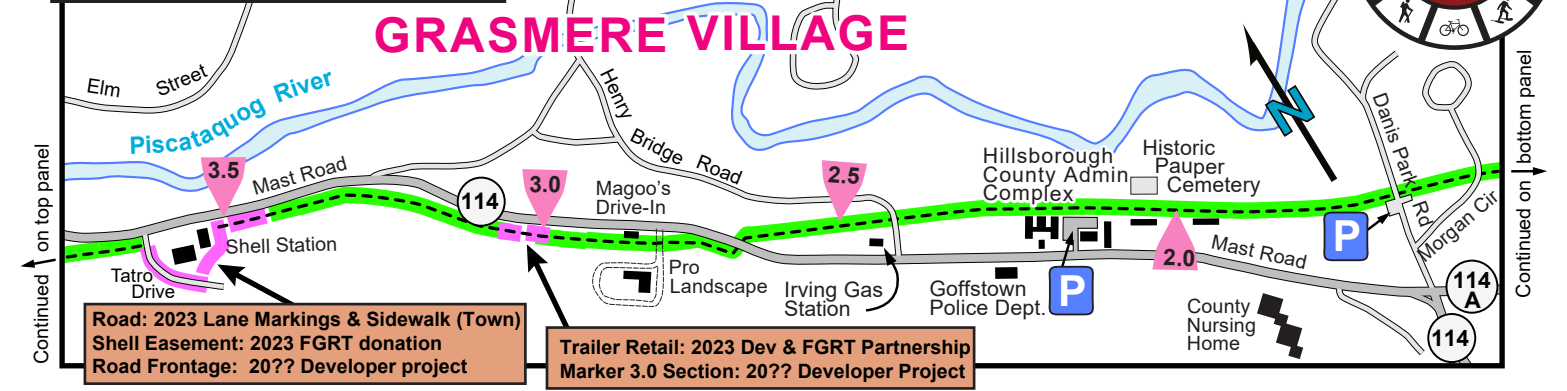
A 5.56-mile long public park managed by the Goffstown Park & Recreation Department.

At end 2022, 91% of trail has an improved surface. The rest is passable with caution.



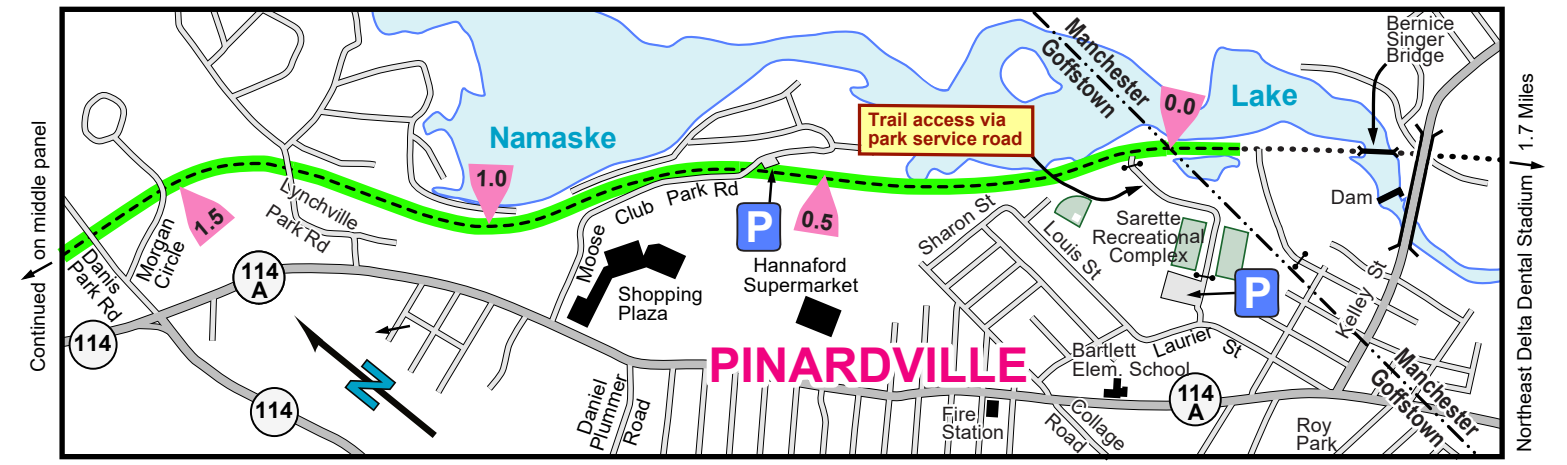

FGRT's role is to assist the P&R Department in trail design, funding, construction and maintenance activities.

The traffic lights along Mast Road are "Pedestrian Hybrid Beacons". This style stays SOLID RED for 7 seconds (persons to start crossing) and then FLASHING RED for 15 seconds (persons finish crossing). **During flashing red, drivers may proceed if their lane is clear.**
