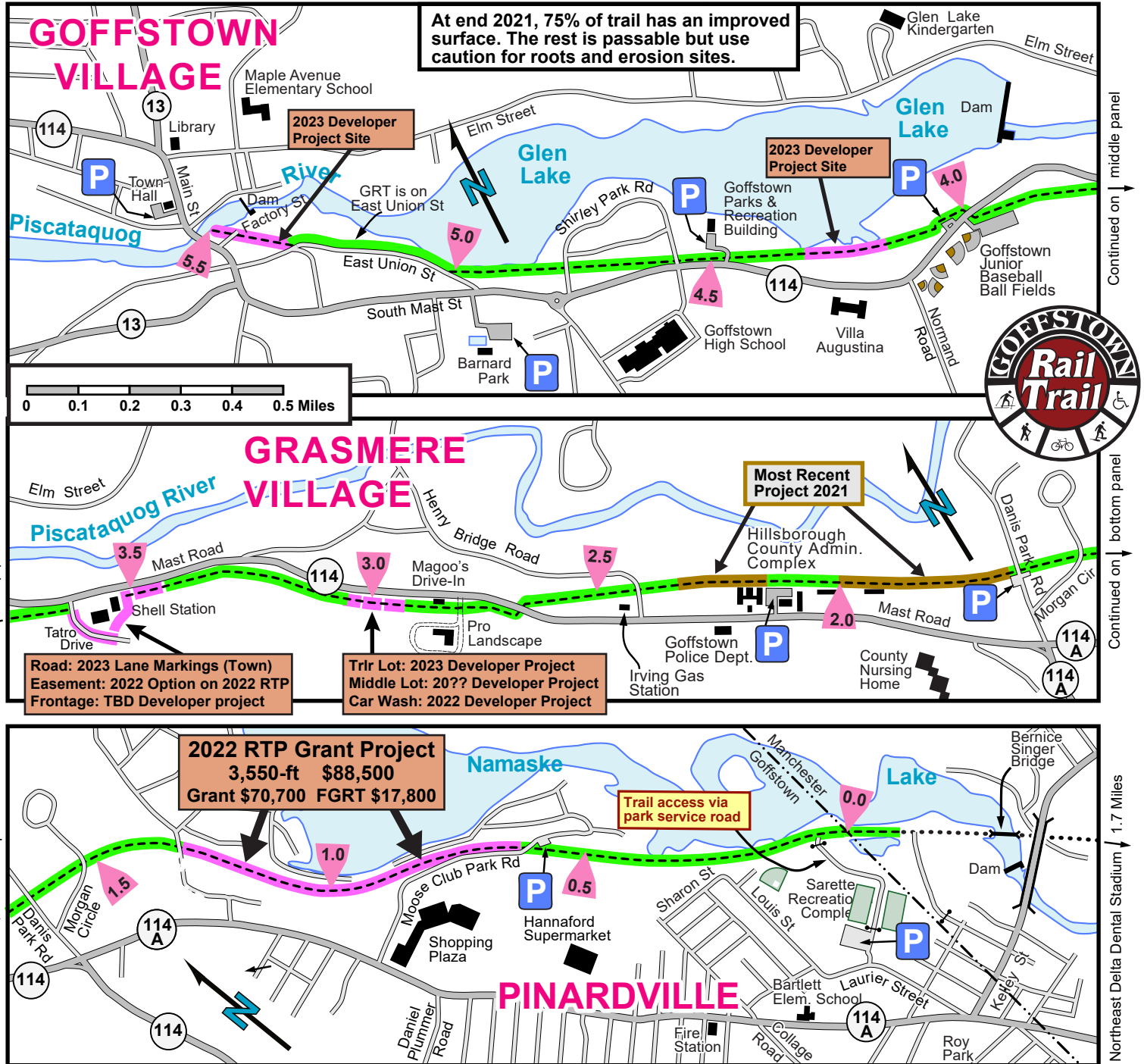


Goffstown Rail Trail

At end 2021, 75% of trail has an improved surface. The rest is passable but use caution for roots and erosion sites.

FGRT's role is to assist the P&R Department in trail design, funding, construction and maintenance activities.

The traffic lights along Mast Road are "Pedestrian Hybrid Beacons". This style stays SOLID RED for 7 seconds (persons to start crossing) and then FLASHING RED for 15 seconds (persons finish crossing). During flashing red, drivers may proceed if their lane is clear.
